**Daycare Bills**

### Italian Monkey Bread

1 loaf Frozen bread dough  
or refrigerated bisque

Italian Seasoning

Garlic

Parmesans Cheese

1 Stick Margarine

Thaw bread dough( do not let it rise). Cut into small pieces. In the mean time, melt margarine and pour into a 9\*13 greased cake pan. Sprinkle with Italian Seasoning, garlic and parmesan cheese to taste. Arrange the bread dough in the pan. Let rise. Bake at 350 for 30 minutes or until golden on top. Remove bread from pan by flipping the pan over and having the bread fall out onto aluminum foil. Serve with warm spaghetti sauce.

### COLD OR FLU

Winter is here and it is the cold and flu season. Here is a check list for you to see if your child has a COLD or the FLU.

#### COLD

- Symptoms develop slowly
- Can occur year-round but is more common in fall and winter
- Runny nose, sneezing, coughing, sore throat
- Mild fatigue
- Normal appetite

#### FLU

- Symptoms come on suddenly
- Usually strikes during the cold-weather
- Muscle aches and pains as well as respiratory symptoms
- High fever accompanied by shills
- Low level of energy
- Little or no appetite

**Please remember that children must be fever free without fever reducers for 24 hrs and symptom free for 24 hrs before returning to childcare. If a child is put on antibiotics then they must be on them for 24hrs before retuning to childcare.**
