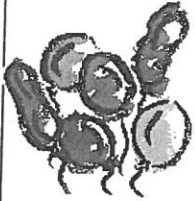

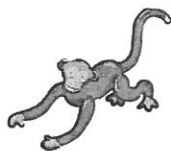
Please listen to KQWC for closings or delay's! We normally try to stay open but if it becomes a safety issue for families or staff to travel then we may have no other choice.

### Italian Monkey Bread

1 loaf Frozen bread dough  
or refrigerated bisque

Italian Seasoning

Garlic

Parmesans Cheese

1 Stick Margarine

Thaw bread dough( do not let it rise). Cut into small pieces. In the mean time, melt margarine and pour into a 9\*13 greased cake pan. Sprinkle with Italian Seasoning, garlic and parmesan cheese to taste. Arrange the bread dough in the pan. Let rise. Bake at 350 for 30 minutes or until golden on top. Remove bread from pan by flipping the pan over and having the bread fall out onto aluminum foil. Serve with warm spaghetti sauce.
