Riverview has been working with a consultant for several months now to plan and build a new daycare center in Webster City. Our current building is at capacity and we currently have 77 children on our waitlist with inquiries about childcare several times a week. Webster City and the surrounding communities have a significant need for more daycare spaces to support working families.
