Dispatchers need to know you're ok. If you hang up they will call back.

Step 2

Answer the call back (if you hung up)

If you don't answer the callback, they will disposen the police to your location.

Step 3

Explain your situation Recisione the dispotcher that your call was an accident and you do not need assistance.

Step 4

Don't beat yourself up
