## SIGN IN/SIGN OUT/SCHEDULED HOURS

As a registered center, we are required to document when children are attending the center.

If the child is left 15 minutes beyond their contracted departure time and the center hasn't been notified staff will contact parents by phone. If we are unable to contact a parent by phone and they have not returned our call within 15 minutes staff will contact the emergency contacts listed on the emergency form. If the child is left 1 hour beyond their contracted departure time and the center hasn't been notified, Riverview staff will assume the child is not being picked up and local authorities will be notified.

Parents must notify the center if a child will be arriving late. If we have not been contacted within an hour of the contracted arrival time, we will contact parents by phone. If we are unable to contact a parent by phone and they have not returned our call within 15 minutes staff will contact the emergency contacts listed on the emergency form. This is for the safety of children & families.
